Notes:

- The Old Course is closed on Sundays. The Castle Course is open from 1 March – tba November 2022. All other courses are open daily throughout the year.
- There are six 18 hole courses and one 9 hole, the Balgove. A single round ticket for the Balgove is valid for two consecutive rounds.
- To play the Old Course, golfers must have a current handicap certificate (maximum – Men 36, Ladies 36).
- Fairway Mats may be in operation on any of the courses during low season
- Day ahead bookings: you may book one day ahead for the Jubilee, Eden, Strathtyrum and Castle. The Jubilee, Eden Strathtyrum and Castle Courses may also be booked up to seven days ahead for Links Ticket Holders by calling (0)1334 466666.
- All 18 hole courses may be booked up to two days in advance, subject to availability. Green fees are payable in full at the time of booking by credit/debit card. Applications should be made to the Reservations office by calling (0)1334 466718.
- Bookings can also be made for the New, Jubilee, Eden, Strathtyrum and Castle online at www.standrews.com
- Three and Seven day tickets are not valid for the Old Course.
- Green fees are not refundable unless the courses are closed by the Links Trust as a result of adverse weather conditions or other reasons
- Bookings made with the Trust by individual golfers are VAT Exempt. VAT is payable on golf bookings not made by individuals, e.g. by commercial concerns such as tour operators, hotels, corporate bookings etc.

- Notes:
1. Applicants for a Resident ticket must prove acceptable proof of permanent residence in St Andrews and be entitled to vote in elections for the local authority. The Trustees have adopted the boundary of the town as contained in the St Andrews Local Area Plan as approved by North East Fife District Council in March 1996
 2. Student tickets are valid from 1 September to 31 August. Matriculation cards need to be shown at the time of purchase and at any subsequent renewal of a ticket. Official handicap certificate/card needed for a full student ticket, to be shown at the time of purchase and at subsequent renewal of a full ticket.
 3. Approved local clubs are St Andrews, New, St Rule, St Regulus and Leuchars Station
 4. Applicants for a North East Fife ticket will have to provide proof of permanent residency in North East Fife and membership of an approved local golf club.
 5. Applicants for an ORD ticket have to provide proof of membership of an approved local golf club.
- General Information:
- a) All Yearly Tickets are valid from 1 April 2022 – 31 March 2023 and are valid for seven-day play unless otherwise stated. Where the ticket is for 5 day play, this is for play on Monday to Friday only.
 - b) A Full Ticket is valid for all courses; a Restricted Ticket excludes the Old Course and The Castle Course.
 - c) To determine qualification for junior categories, the applicant's age on 1st April applies.
 - d) Proof of handicap is only required if a golfer is changing from a Restricted ticket to a Full ticket or is offered a Full ticket for the first time (not required for Resident tickets).
 - e) Please note that all Restricted Ticket holders (including Youth and Junior Tickets) are entitled to two rounds on The Castle Course per annum on payment of a surcharge of £10 per round at the point of play.
 - f) Please note there is a waiting list in operation for NEF, ORD & OLT categories of ticket
