Old Course - Dark Times

'Dark times' are those tee times where it might not be possible to complete your round of golf before darkness falls. There is however still demand to play in these times on the Old Course and it is important to allocate these in a consistent manner.

'Dark times' are allocated as follows:

- 'Dark times' will be available for Yearly Ticket holders to introduce guests, or for visitors to play, up to **ONE** hour after the last published ballot time (**7** 'dark times' available).
- A Yearly Ticket holder may at any time **on the day** book a 'dark time' with the Starter **in person** at the Starter's Box. The time is allocated at this stage and details of additional golfers can be finalised at the time of play.
- Yearly Ticket holders have priority in the booking of these 'dark times' but should a time not have been booked **30 minutes** prior to play, they can be allocated to a visiting golfer via the waiting list operating on the day. Before confirming a tee time, the golfer must be fully aware that they may not complete their round and that a refund will not be applicable.
- Once the 7 'dark times' have been used, no green fees will be accepted and the course is only available for Yearly Ticket holders to start their round prior to the 1st tee closing.
- Please note that Dark Times secured by a Yearly Ticket Holder should not be used for commercial/personal financial gain. If this is found to be the case, action may be taken against the Yearly Ticket Holder involved.
